The Kendriya Hindi Sansthan (KHS) Agra is an Autonomous Body of Ministry of Education, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of India, which was established in 1960 and run under the Kendriya Hindi Shikshan Mandal invites **online applications** through its official website: <https://hindisansthan.in> from Indian citizens, in the prescribed format, to fill the following vacant posts in the **Academic Cadre** at the Headquarters of the Kendriya Hindi Sansthan in Agra, its existing centers, as well as the centers to be established in the future:-

- The applicants may note that all of the above posts are all India cadre, liable to be posted/transferred in any of its offices/centers across the country.

**IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- Schedule of submission of online application, followed by submission of Hard copy, is as under: -
  - Starting date of Online Registration/Submission of application: 05<sup>th</sup> April, 2026.
  - Last date of Online Registration/Submission of application: 04<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 by 11.59 p.m. (IST) [after which the application link will be disabled]
  - Last date of receipt of hard copies – After submission of the online application, the candidate shall forward a duly signed hard copy of the application, along with self-attested copies of all supporting documents to “**The Registrar, Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Hindi Sansthan Marg, Agra-282002 (U.P.)**” through registered/speed post within the **10 days from the last date** of the online application (i.e. 15 May 2026).

- Applicants must complete both the online application and the physical submission of a hard copy by the deadline. Failure to fulfill this **dual requirement** may result in rejection without further notice. Candidates must upload high-quality scanned copies of all essential documents with their online application, followed by the submission of self-attested physical hard copy.

**METHOD OF SELECTIONS BY DIRECT RECRUITMENT:**

- The posts listed above are to be filled through Direct Recruitment. Candidates applying for such posts are required to submit their applications online in the prescribed format for Direct Recruitment, along with the requisite application fee.
- Those candidates who are in employment with state/Central Govt./PSU/Autonomous Bodies, must submit a **“NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE”** from the employer at the time of verification of documents/at the time of interview, whichever is applicable. Failure to submit the NOC will lead to cancellation of candidature.
- The detailed procedure of Scrutiny of the Applications, Shortlisting Criteria & Syllabus for OMR based examination consisting of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs), Assessment Criteria (Video presentation, Assessment of Research Aptitude and Writing Skills & PPT presentation) for understanding the Abilities of the Shortlisted Candidates, Document Verification and Face-to-Face Interview for all the Shortlisted Candidates will be announced shortly on the official website at <https://hindisansthan.in>**
- An OMR based examination consisting of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) will be conducted during Selection Process for the post of Assistant Professor (Pay Level 10) only.** If the number of applications for the post of Assistant Professor (Pay Level 10) is less than 15, the Competent Authority reserves the right **to either conduct or not conduct the examination**, and eligible candidates may be called directly for an interview.

**QUALIFICATIONS & ELIGIBILITY:**

- Qualifications and other eligibility criteria for all the above posts are at Annexure-I.** However, for detailed information, candidates are advised to go through Regulations on Recruitment Rules of UGC/NCTE.
- Further updates:**  
The date of conduct of interviews will be intimated in due course only through the website at <https://hindisansthan.in>. Further, candidates are advised to visit the website of the KHS on regular basis to get updates. No further personal communications are made.
- The crucial date for determining the eligibility shall be last date of submission of online application.

**APPLICATION FEES:**

- The candidate can get the online application form for a post and Payment link after Registering himself/herself at the link given below. After registering he may select the post to apply for and thereafter he/she will get the online application form with payment link. If the candidate desires to apply for another post, he/she may not need registering again and can proceed with the same registration number. However, for applying to another post requires payment of fee for that post.

- Any other mode of payment, except online in the link given in the application, shall not be accepted towards application fee. The application fee shall be paid strictly as per the applicant's category and amount prescribed, failing which, the application will be deemed as invalid. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. This fee is against application for one post only. If the candidate is applying for a different post (i.e, already applied for Assistant Professor (Linguistics), now wants to apply for Assistant Professor (Education), prescribed payment for the second post also required to be paid separately. Similarly, the excess payment made, if any, shall not be refunded. In cases where the fee paid

is less than the prescribed amount, the deficit must be remitted immediately; failing which, the application will be deemed as invalid. It is the absolute responsibility of the applicant to pay the prescribed fee and mention in the application that he/she has paid full prescribed fee. Incomplete application/applications submitted without requisite fee shall be rejected.

13. It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to apply correctly against a post as notified in this advertisement and its reserved category. Any application submitted with incorrect or mismatched information shall become infructuous and not actionable without any further correspondence.

#### **RESERVATION AND RELAXATION RELATED GUIDELINES IN RECRUITMENT**

##### **QUALIFICATIONS & OTHER RELAXATIONS:**

14. Relaxation in qualifying marks, etc., may be granted to the candidates belonging to the Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribes/OBC/PwBD category for reserved posts as per the UGC/Govt. of India guidelines. A certificate to this effect issued from the competent authority should be attached with the prescribed application form. Wherever a relaxation of qualification, including percentage of marks, is permitted under the UGC/Govt. of India guidelines, such relaxation shall also be considered in appropriate cases subject to recommendations of the Screening Committee.

##### **SUBMISSION OF VALID CERTIFICATES FOR RESERVED CATEGORIES - TREATMENT OF RESERVED CATEGORY CANDIDATES SELECTED ON MERIT - APPLICATION OF RELAXED STANDARDS AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - PROVISIONAL APPOINTMENT SUBJECT TO VERIFICATION - GENERAL NOTE ON RESERVATION AND CONCESSIONS:**

15. The candidate belonging to the reserved categories shall enclose self-attested copies of the Caste/Class certificate from the Competent Authority in the format prescribed by the Government of India (subject to verification at a later date), failing which the application shall be rejected.
16. A candidate belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS who has been selected on the same standard as applied to the General candidates and who appears in the general merit list is to be treated as own merit candidate. Such candidate will be adjusted against unreserved point of the reservation roster.
17. When a relaxed standard is applied in selecting an SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidate, for example in the qualification etc., the SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidates are to be considered against reserved vacancies only.
18. Appointment of SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD candidates (as the case may be), will be provisional, subject to verification of related Certificates/documents.
19. Applicants seeking reservation benefits available for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD category and fees concession for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD, must submit the necessary documents justifying the claim of respective reservation as per Government of India rules/norms. The Caste Certificate uploaded should be in the format prescribed by the Union Government and should be digitally verifiable.

##### **CASTE/CATEGORY CERTIFICATE:**

20. Candidates applying under any of the reserved category viz. SC/ST/OBC(NCL) will be considered subject to submission of valid Caste certificate on a prescribed format issued by the Competent Authority.
21. **OBC Certificates:** The vacancies are being advertised in financial year 2025-26, therefore, valid NCL-OBC certificate issued on or after 01.04.2025 will be considered valid. NCL-OBC certificate issued before 01.04.2025 will not be considered valid for this advertisement. Candidates applying under OBC category must produce the valid caste certificate in the form as provided by the DoPT vide O.M. No. 36036/2/2013 -Estt.(Res.) dated 30.05.2014 and further clarification issued by DoPT OM No. 36036/2/2013-Estt.(Res-I) dated 31.03.2016. Certificate must be valid for employment in Central Government Institutions. OBC candidate's eligibility will be based on Castes borne in the Central List of Govt. of India. Their Sub-caste should also match with the entries in Central List of OBC, failing which their candidature as OBC candidate will not be considered. They will however be treated as UR candidate. The OBC certificate should clearly show that the applicant does not belong to the Creamy Layer. The certificate submitted should be digitally verifiable. Applicants should ascertain that they belong to the reserved categories (caste) enlisted in the Central list for the Other Backward Classes. Self-declaration in the prescribed format. They shall ensure that their Community falls under the Central List of OBCs as approved by the Government of India. **Self-attested copy of OBC certificate and self-declaration as to OBC (Non-Creamy layer) should be annexed to hard copy of online application along-with other necessary enclosures.**

## **CERTIFICATE OF EWS CANDIDATES**

22. The vacancies advertised under EWS Category are as per the instructions issued by DoPT, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pension, Govt. of India, vide OM. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019. Application under EWS category will be considered subject to submission of Income and Assets certificate on a prescribed format, valid for the current financial year, issued by the competent authority and subject to verification of genuineness of the certificate by the issuing authority:
- (i) **District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/Additional' Deputy Commissioner/ 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner.**
  - (ii) **Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate.**
  - (iii) **Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.**
  - (iv) **Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his/her family normally resides.**
23. As per DoPT OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019. Therefore, a valid EWS certificate (current Financial Year) will be the one which has been issued by the competent authority, as prescribed by the GOI/DoPT, on or before the last date of submission of online application. Candidates who fail to produce valid EWS certificate will not be considered for reservation under this category. They will however be treated as UR candidate. The EWS candidate must ensure that they have a valid EWS certificate on or before the last date of submission of application.

## **GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

24. The fields provided in the online application form may be expanded to furnish necessary additional information.
25. **The applicant will be solely responsible for the authenticity of the information submitted by him/her.**
26. The last dates as prescribed above may be extended by the Competent Authority of KHS, at its discretion, depending upon the exigencies of the situation. The Competent Authority can also issue amendments to the notification as per rules, if the circumstances so warrant. Further notification/updates in this regard will be placed on the website of the KHS, Delhi only. The candidates are strictly advised to visit the KHS's website <https://hindisansthan.in> for all further updates/amendments regularly.
27. **Advice to avoid delay:** Candidates are advised to apply well before the prescribed last date of submission of application to avoid facing any hindrance in submission of online applications before the last date, due to probable heavy load on network/server. KHS will not entertain any complaint in this regard.
28. **Accuracy of contact details:** Candidates must exercise extreme care when entering their contact information, especially their email ID, registered mobile number, and alternate mobile number. Errors in these fields may prevent essential communications, and KHS will not be responsible for any resulting failure to communicate. Candidates must ensure that the e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in the Online Application Form are their own or accessible to them at all times.
29. **The date for determining the eligibility of all candidates in every respect shall be considered upto the closing date of the online application as prescribed in the advertisement.** In other words, no candidate shall be allowed to attend interview if he/she does not possess the minimum qualification and experience etc. as on the closing date of the online application for a particular post.

## **OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

30. **Right of amendment and communication:** The KHS reserves the right to alter/insert any corrections/additions in the advertisement in the event of any necessity etc., for which the candidates are advised to be in the lookout for announcements/notifications/updates in the website of KHS. Information relating to selection process of above posts will be notified through website of KHS only. Candidates are advised to regularly visit the said website. No other mode of communication will be adopted by the KHS.
31. Mere possession of eligibility conditions shall not entitle a candidate to be called for Interview/Skill Tests. The date for determining the eligibility of all candidates in every respect shall be the closing date as prescribed in the advertisement for receipt of the applications. In other words, no candidate shall be eligible for interview/skill test if he/she does not possess the minimum qualification and experience etc. as on the closing date of the application for a particular post.

## **DISQUALIFICATION**

32. The following categories of persons shall not be eligible to apply for any position in the KHS:
- i. Who has been convicted by any Court of Law or any criminal proceedings are pending against him/her;
  - ii. Who is a person of unsound mind and questionable conduct or not medically fit to perform his/her duties.
  - iii. Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a living spouse; Provided that the Competent Authority of the Sansthan may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these rules;
  - iv. Who is not a citizen of India; and
  - v. Any other category of person disqualified for appointment by the Govt. of India/State Govt./UGC from time to time.
33. **OTHER GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:**
- (a) Candidates will have to present themselves for the interview/examination at their own expenses.
  - (b) Candidates should bring all certificates in original at the time of verification of documents/interview/any other date whichever is communicated by the KHS.
  - (c) Candidature of applicants are liable to be cancelled/rejected summarily at any stage of the recruitment process in the event of all or any of the following: -
    - i. Applications being incomplete.
    - ii. Application made in the form other than the form available in the KHS's website.
    - iii. Any variation in the Signatures and Photographs. (All the photographs & signatures, pasted/uploaded/done on the Application Form and also on other Documents must be the same.)
    - iv. Fee not paid as per instructions.
    - v. Non-forwarding of Self Attested legible copies of all the relevant Certificates/Documents and clear self-attested photographs in support of the information given in their Application about their Educational Qualifications, Experiences, Percentage of Marks obtained, Proof of Category etc.
    - vi. Not having the requisite Educational Qualification/Experience/Category Status as on the closing date of the online application.
    - vii. Incorrect information or misrepresentation or suppression of material facts.
    - viii. Non-receipt/Late receipt of the prescribed Application Form (Hard Copy) along with self-attested copies of the relevant documents.
    - ix. If the candidate is found using unfair means or adopting any malpractice at any stage of selection process.
    - x. Non-production of Original Certificates at the time of Verification of Documents.
    - xi. Any other irregularity.
34. Acceptance of documents/certificates/claims etc. submitted by an applicant will be subject to their verification by the Competent Authorities/Sources. If, any claim/certificate/document is found to be false/fake/incorrect/mala-fide at any stage of verification before or after appointment, the candidature shall be summarily rejected and action may be initiated against the candidate for this misconduct including rejection of his/her candidature, debarment for further examinations, cancellation of his/her appointment, if already appointed. It may also lead to initiation of criminal action.
35. The candidate will have to present himself/herself for interview/examination, if called for, at the place and time fixed by the KHS at his/her own expenses.
36. Admit card/Interview call letter as applicable may be issued provisionally, on the basis of information furnished by the candidate in his/her application. Such provisional admission is subject to verification of the documents. The Kendriya Hindi Sansthan may not verify/scrutinize this information in advance and therefore, mere appearance at the Interview/examination will not, in any way, entitle him/her to claim for the post.
37. It may be noted that candidates found Eligible/Provisionally Eligible will have to undergo Interview (as applicable) in the first instance. Schedule of Interview (as applicable) will be displayed in KHS's website in due course. After the conclusion of interviews, a list of candidates appeared for interviews and their marks and the merit list along with Panel candidates for each post will be displayed.

38. The candidature will be treated as invalid ab-initio, in case he/she does not fulfill the eligibility criteria. Candidate should satisfy himself/herself regarding the possession of the required qualifications, age, caste etc., as stipulated for the post; he/she has applied for as on last date of receipt of applications.
39. If any candidate appearing for any interview finds that his/her name, reservation category, post name, post code, photo or signature is missing or is incorrect in his/her Admit Card, he/she should get it rectified by visiting the office of the KHS. The KHS will not make any kind of corrections in admit cards received by post. No modification, whatsoever, in the admit card at the interview will be allowed.
40. The employees of the KHS are liable to serve anywhere in the country or outside the country where the Centers, offices or projects of the KHS are located or may be located in future.
41. The grade/credit points will be counted as per guidelines of the UGC/CSU/GoI.
42. Candidate should bring all original certificates relating to his / her age, qualification, experience and caste etc. at the time of Document Verification. In case the candidate fails to submit the original documents for verification of the certified / xerox copies of the enclosures to his/her application, he or she shall not be allowed to appear at the interview/examination/document verification and his/her candidature shall be treated as cancelled without any further communication in this regard.
43. Candidates must be in sound health. They must, if selected be prepared to undergo such medical examination and satisfy such medical authority as the KHS may require.
44. The Candidates should keep a copy of Application printout alongwith fee submission receipt for producing at the time of Document Verification and also for their future reference.
45. The KHS has framed/adopted Selection Criteria for particularized posts for recruitments. The KHS reserves the right to modify the Criteria concerning the recruitment and/or to add/withdraw the post(s) in from the purview as per requirement.
46. If the relevant certificates for respective reserved categories are not submitted with the application, the application may be rejected and no appeal against its rejection will be entertained.
47. The terms and conditions of appointment shall be communicated to the candidate in the form of "Offer of Appointment" to the selected candidates. If the candidate does not accept the terms and conditions mentioned in the offer of appointment within the stipulated time, the offer shall be treated as withdrawn.
48. The select panel of candidates for this recruitment process will be valid for the prescribed period as per KHS norms.
49. The Kendriya Hindi Sansthan reserves the right to reject any application without assigning any reason thereof. The KHS reserves the right to increase or decrease the vacancies according to the circumstances, which will be notified.
50. Interim enquiries shall not be entertained.
51. **Statutory Warning:** Selection shall be conducted on a **free, fair, and strictly merit-based principle**. Any attempt detected to influence, compromise, or subvert the selection process, at any stage, shall result in the immediate termination of candidature/ termination of service and the institution shall initiate legal action against the concerned individual.
52. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
53. In case of any dispute in this regard, any suit or legal proceeding against the Sansthan, the territorial jurisdiction shall be **Hon'ble Courts in UP**.
54. Candidates should keep visiting the website of KHS regularly for all important updates/ announcements/information/corrigendum/notices and other details related to selection processes at various stages for filling up of the advertised position. No other mode of communication will be adopted by the KHS.

55. In case of any grievance of any candidate relating to recruitment, the candidate may also approach the Director/Registrar of KHS in writing for redressal sufficiently in advance.
56. Regarding any ambiguity, relating to the recruitment rules in general and eligibility etc. in respect of any post in particular, the decision of the Competent Authority of the KHS shall be final.

**Qualifications and other eligibility criteria for the above-mentioned posts**

**I. Professor:**

**Eligibility (A or B):**

(A).

- (i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of UGC regulations, 2018, Notification dated 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2018..
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

**OR**

- (B). An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

**II. Professor (For Education Discipline):**

**Following qualification is as per NCTE Regulation, 2014 &/ or 2019 which shall be in accordance with the UGC Regulations, 2018 also otherwise:**

**Eligibility (A or B):**

(A).

- (i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in Education or concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of UGC Regulations-2018, Notification dated 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2018.
- (ii) Postgraduate degree in Science or Mathematics or Social Science or Commerce or Languages with minimum 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in point scale wherever the grading system is followed) from an Indian University or, an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (iii) M.Ed/M.A. in Education or equivalent degree with minimum 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in point scale wherever the grading system is followed) from an Indian University or, an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (iv) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

**OR**

- (B). An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

#### **IV. Associate Professor:**

##### **Eligibility**

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of Seventy-five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of UGC regulations, 2018, Notification dated 18th July, 2018.

#### **V. Assistant Professor:**

##### **Eligibility (A or B):**

(A)

- (i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Education or concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are of have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (minimum Standards and procedure for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- (b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- (c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- (d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal or UGC listed journal;
- (e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/ seminars sponsored/funded/ supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

**OR**

- (B) The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of UGC Regulations-2018, Notification dated 18th July, 2018 for universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

##### **Desirable - for Assistant Professor teaching in any subject:**

- a. Research degree in concerned subject or published research work of outstanding value.
- b. Knowledge of Methodology of Language teaching.
- c. Knowledge of online teaching and basic computer applications
- d. Teaching experience in concerned subject.

## **VI. Assistant Professor (for Education Discipline):**

Following qualification is as per NCTE Regulation, 2014 &/ or 2019 which shall be in accordance with the UGC Regulations, 2018 also otherwise:

### **Eligibility (A or B):**

(A)

- (i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Education or concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) M.Ed/M.A. in Education or equivalent degree with minimum 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in point scale wherever the grading system is followed) from an Indian University or, an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (iii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are of have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (minimum Standards and procedure for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- (b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- (c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- (d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal or UGC listed journal;
- (e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/ seminars sponsored/funded/ supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

**OR**

- (B) The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of UGC Regulations-2018, Notification dated 18th July, 2018 for universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

**Note: In respect of subjects for concerned posts, the decision of the screening committee regarding Concerned/Allied/Relevant subject shall be final.**
